1. Motion to update rule XI, D3; to add “When singing the first and second reading for the judge(s), it will be a rule violation if the choir stops and restarts”.

Motion by Mark Cain, second by Lori Daubenspeck. Motion passed 10-0

2. Motion to update rule XI, G; to add “It will be a rule violation if the second reading is not sung with ALL students singing the printed text”.

Motion by Mark Cain, second by Marilyn Meyers. Motion passed 10-0

3. Motion to accept the updated *Prescribed Music Lists* or Band Orchestra and Choir and the *Advanced Literature List* as presented by the PML committees for 2016-2019.

4. Motion to remove “Parade Snare” from the list of eligible solos.

Motion by Rusty Chevalier, second by Sarah Neely. Motion passed 10-0

5. Motion to delete from rule X, section D4; “Composite high school bands, jazz bands, orchestras, and choruses are permitted in class’s 2A, 3A, and 4A only, exceptions must be approved by the OSSAA. Composite Class E jazz bands or jazz combos are not allowed from any classification.”

Motion made by Rusty Chevalier, Second by David Hilger. Motion passed 10-0

6. Motion to move the 2A-4A Band and 2A-4A Choir State contests to week to week 39 from week 42.

7. Motion to remove from rule X A,1; and C1; the word “each” from the rule “Two selections, **each** by a different composer, and at least one of which must appear on the current OSSAA Prescribed Music List”.
