We are very proud to hold the Swimming State Championships at The Jenks Aquatic Center located at 205 "B" Street Jenks, OK. The following is a list of **mandatory** guidelines that will be strictly adhered to at the competition.

- **Team Bus Parking Information:** Please see the site specific information at the end of this correspondence.
- **Spectator Parking:** Spectators may park in any designated parking space at the Aquatic Center. There is **NO PARKING** on the grass.
- **Coaches:** Please dispense your food and drink to your individual swimmers before they enter. **There will be no coolers allowed on the deck.** We will expect that each team police their area before you leave and dispose of any trash.
- Entry into the pool for **all** participants and coaches will be through the main entrance of the Jenks Aquatic Center. Deck access is for participants, coaches, and officials only.
- Only swimmers that have qualified for the State Meet will be allowed on the pool deck. All other athletes must purchase a ticket to be admitted to the event and sit in the spectator seating. **Spectators may not enter the pool deck or the restroom facilities in the locker rooms. There are restroom facilities available for spectators, in the lobby.**
- **ON FRIDAY AND SATURDAY--During the Class 5A meet, only Class 5A swimmers and coaches will be allowed on deck. During the Class 6A meet, only Class 6A swimmers and coaches will be allowed on deck. 6A teams and spectators will not be allowed to enter the facility until the prior meet has ended and the facility has been cleared.**
- Only head coaches and school verified assistant coaches will be allowed on the pool deck with an OSSAA issued pass.
- The list of schools providing timers is below. Please have 2 adults available to time for both sessions. Lane assignments have been determined. The timers will check in at the athlete check in table to be issued their pass for the day. You may use two different people the second day than you used the first, but please do not switch out timers during a session.
- Participants may bring drinks for themselves. **No ice chests will be permitted on the pool deck** or in the spectator area. Concessions will be available both days. Tables are strictly prohibited on the deck. No glass is allowed on the pool deck. Please make sure that all trash is thrown in trash receptacles.
- Kukulski Brothers will be selling State Championship T-shirts and memorabilia.
- In compliance with the OSSAA's commitment to provide the safest environment possible for participants, deck access will be limited to coaches, participants, and workers only. Deck passes will be provided in the packet with your heat sheets. You will get 2 per school in your packet. Additional passes *may* be approved by OSSAA, but OSSAA reserves the right to deny additional passes.
- Participants do not need a deck pass; however, participants will be marked accordingly for deck access.
- Please advise your swimmers to take a cleansing shower with soap prior to entering the water in accordance with the State Health Department regulations. Shaving is prohibited at the site, including the locker rooms.
- Please advise your swimmers they must refrain from going up in the spectator area. This creates a liability for the pool. We ask you to monitor your own swimmers so security can tend to their assigned areas.
- Please note the coaches meeting schedule below.
- Music for the Finals will be provided by the OSSAA. Participants will not provide any music for the event.
- No flash photography at the start of an event. There will be no deck access for spectators during the awards presentation.

We appreciate your cooperation in regard to helping provide a safe environment for our competition.

PLEASE NOTE: ON FRIDAY AND SATURDAY, THE AQUATIC CENTER WILL BE CLEARED UPON COMPLETION OF THE 5A MEET. DOORS WILL OPEN FOR SPECTATORS AT APPROXIMATELY 4:00 P.M. FOR CLASS 6A EACH DAY. ATHLETES AND SPECTATORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO REMAIN IN THE FACILITY UPON COMPLETION OF THE CLASS 5A PRELIMINARIES OR FINALS.

There will **not** be a coaches meeting scheduled on Saturday, however questions can be addressed to the Meet Referee, or Amy Cassell prior to the start of the meet.

Awards will be given during breaks. Be sure your athletes are at the awards stands to receive their medals, we cannot wait for athletes to show before presenting medals. Medals will be given by OSSAA Staff. The schedule for the awards is listed below.

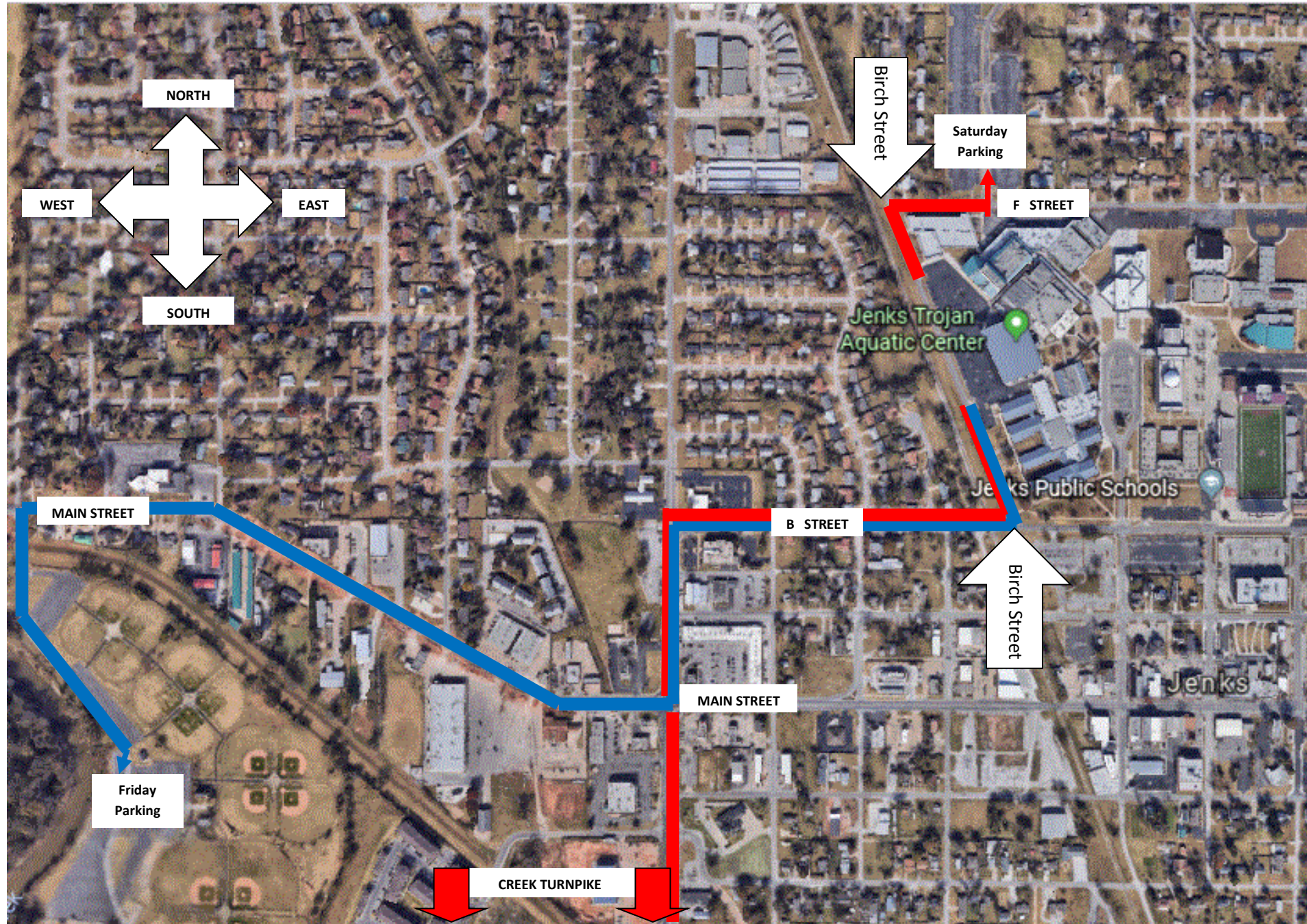

Oklahoma 5A & 6A State Swim Meet at Jenks Aquatic Center

Friday, February 21, 2020

Directions & Parking Instructions:

Off of the Creek Turnpike, take the Peoria/Elm exit into Jenks and go north. At “B” Street, turn right (east) and go to Birch (this is the first left after the railroad tracks). Busses should enter the parking lot at the first entrance to the Jenks Aquatic Center and drop off athletes/coaches. Bus parking for **Friday** will be at the Jenks City Park West facility off of South KOA. We will have a driver to show you the location and bring you back to the Aquatic Center and also shuttle you back to your buses at the end of the session. Shuttles will run approximately every 15 minutes between this lot and the Aquatic Center after initial drop off and at the conclusion of the morning and afternoon sessions. The lot directly in front of the Aquatic Center (Lot # 1) will be reserved for swim meet officials and volunteers.

Bus parking for **Saturday**: Drivers will drop off at the same location and then proceed back out to Birch St. and take a right and go to the stop sign to the North. Make another right at the stop sign and you can park your buses in the parking lot to the North of our Music Building/HS Building #5. There will be no shuttles run on **Saturday**.

Warm-up/Cool-down pools: 4-8 lanes will be available during competition for warm-up and cool-down in the main pool (except lanes directly adjacent to bulkheads). An additional warm-up/cool-down area will be available in the Instructional Pool.
