



OSSAA MEDIA GUIDELINES FOR FAST-PITCH SOFTBALL STATE TOURNAMENTS

Face coverings will be required for all media members.

Post-game interviews should be conducted while wearing face coverings and maintaining at least six feet of distance between the interviewer and the coach or player being interviewed. No interviews will be allowed on the fields at either venue.

Media will be allowed in the press box with a face covering at Hall of Fame Stadium. Seating will be limited and some media may have to cover the games from outside the press box.

Media tables will be set up by each dugout at the Ball Fields at Firelake for radio stations and newspapers. Media will NOT be allowed in the press box at the Ball Fields at Firelake.

No media will be allowed in the dugouts for any reason. Photographers will need to bring step stools to shoot over the fence down the baselines at the Ball Fields at Firelake.

If the team you are covering is not playing, please allow working media to use the spots in the press box at Hall of Fame Stadium and at the tables at the Ball Fields at Firelake. Once your game has ended, please allow media for the next contest to set up for their game. This may require writing your story from an alternate location.

No spouses, children or friends will be allowed in the press boxes or at the media tables.

If you have any special requests, please contact the OSSAA three (3) days prior to the tournament starting.

Please be respectful, patient and understanding of others during these trying times.
