RE: Regional Cheerleading Information and Regional Competition Assignments
DATE: September 1, 2021

Below you will find assignments and other information for the regional cheerleading competition. Please review this material carefully, as there will be no mailing to your school. The regional competition will be held on September 18, 2021. Floor passes for the regional competition can be picked up at the check in table at your regional site. These are the ONLY passes you will receive for regionals, lost or misplaced floor passes will not be replaced.

There will be two Regional Competition sites, Chickasha High School and Stroud High School. Each competition will begin at the assigned times. **You will be sent information from your assigned site via email prior to the competition.**

NOTE: Fans and squads are **not allowed** to bring spirit posters, banners, etc. Admission prices are \$7.00 for adults and \$7.00 for students. All tickets will be sold online only. NO TICKETS CAN BE PURCHASED AT THE SITE. The link for purchasing tickets can be found on the homepage of OSSAA.com. The link will open on September 13 at 9 a.m. The 2021-2022 OSSAA play-off pass will be the only pass accepted.

STATE CHAMPIONSHIP PROGRAM: Please remember that we will have a State Championship Program. You should email your squad's picture and roster to Rod Coulter at programs@vype.com, no later than September 18, 2021.

It is mandatory that cheer squads remain in their school uniforms throughout the entirety of the competition for their respective classification. This includes the awards portion of the competition.

MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED AT REGIONAL SITES.

- **COACHES WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES WHILE AT THE COMPETITION SITE.**
- **CHEERLEADERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK EXCEPT WHILE ON THE COMPETITION FLOOR.**
- **SPECTATORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES.**
SOCIAL DISTANCING PROTOCOLS WILL BE IN PLACE, ALL COACHES, PARTICIPANTS AND SPECTATORS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLY.
- **AFTER EACH CLASSIFICATION COMPLETES SQUADS ARE FREE TO LEAVE. QUALIFIERS WILL BE POSTED TO THE SPIRIT PAGE OF OSSAA.COM SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 18 BY 9 P.M. NO AWARDS WILL BE GIVEN AT THE SITE. REGIONAL WINNER'S PLAQUES WILL BE SHIPPED DIRECTLY TO THE SCHOOL.**

STUNT REVIEW PROCESS: Any requests for stunt review must be send to mwoods@ossaa.com. You will receive a written response to your review request within 48 hours via email. If you had a stunt reviewed regarding the legality of your squad's routine you must take a copy with you to your regional site. Stunt reviews may be submitted until September 13, 2021.

POINTS OF EMPHASIS:

1. **MUSIC COMPLIANCE STATEMENT:** For the Regional Competition a Music Compliance Statement form must be on file with the OSSAA prior to September 15, 2021. The form can be found on the Cheer page of OSSAA.com.
 - A MUSIC COMPLIANCE STATEMENT FORM MUST BE ON FILE FOR EVERY SCHOOL USING MUSIC. SCHOOLS USING MUSIC WITHOUT A FORM WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO USE MUSIC IN THEIR REGIONAL ROUTINE.
 - WE WILL TRACK BY REGIONAL WHO HAS SUBMITTED A FORM, VERIFY THE MUSIC IS ASCAP LICENSED AND SEND THE LIST TO THE SITE MANAGER OF EACH REGIONAL.
 - FORMS MUST BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 15, 2021 FOR THE REGIONAL COMPETITION. SUBMIT TO mwoods@ossaa.com
 - FOR SQUADS USING MUSIC A SECOND MUSIC COMPLIANCE STATEMENT FORM FOR THE STATE COMPETITION MUST BE ON FILE WITH THE OSSAA NO LATER THAN September 22, 2021. SCHOOLS WITHOUT A FORM WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO USE MUSIC IN THEIR STATE ROUTINE
2. The area used for competition must be matted.
3. The squad must use a minimum of one and one-half minutes of the two-minute time limit. Up to 45 seconds of music may be used in accordance to the above requirements. There is no minimum time limit. Music in a routine will not affect the judging of the routine in any manner. Cheer coaches will be responsible for playing their own music at both the regional and state competitions. A sound system will be provided.
4. The timing begins after squad has set in formation on the matted area with the first motion, word, skill, or music. The timing ends with the last word or motion. The squad must use a minimum of 1 1/2 minutes of the two-minute time limit.
5. Use of or the attempted use of illegal stunts or formations will result in a 10-point deduction per score sheet at the regional competition. A rule violation at State will result in a disqualification.
6. If the cheer routine is interrupted by an injury to one of the participants, the coach may choose to finish the routine from the point of interruption or choose to take the score earned to that point, without any deduction for the minimum time limit not being met.

7. In the event of a tie, all judges' score sheets will be used for the tied squads. If the additional score sheets do not break the tie; the teams will be awarded the appropriate places.
8. See the 2021-2022 OSSAA Spirit manual for further information concerning managing a regional competition.
9. Coaches who have not attended a rules meeting will be prohibited from coaching.
10. The performance order for the squads competing at the Regional and State competition has been set by the OSSAA staff. (NOTE: The order has been randomly selected by the OSSAA staff.) The order of competition is as listed on each regional sheet. An emergency will be the only exception for being late. If an emergency occurs, contact the site manager.
