Game Day Regionals 2021

Enid High School is excited to be hosting the 4A-6A OSSAA Game Day Cheer Regionals Saturday, November 6th. Hopefully, you have had the opportunity to look over the format provided by OSSAA. Our goal is to cover specifics and answer any questions you may have before Saturday.

- You will have a specified check-in time; stretching time; warm up time, and performance time. The schedule is attached. If there are changes that need to be made after sending, I will email you a new schedule.
- You will perform all three elements during your performance time. The order will be Band Dance, Crowd Leading, and Fight Song.
 - Band Dance - you cue music; time starts
 - Crowd Leading - after Band Dance, you have three 8-counts prior to the beginning of Crowd Leading. You should designate someone to speak the 8 counts out loud to avoid confusion, (counts may be spoken by the coach or a designated participant).
 - Fight Song - after Crowd Leading, you have another three 8 counts to prepare for the last element, Fight Song. You will cue the music and your time will start.

We will continue to be mindful of the ongoing COVID situation, and work to keep teams as safe as possible:

- If you arrive earlier than your check in time, please sit in the 2nd level section of the arena. We do have locker rooms if needed for restroom use only (do not leave personal items).
- Do not try to enter the stretching area or warm-up room until someone has directed your team. Please allow space for the team exiting to travel through before you enter the stretching room or warm-up room.
- **Results will be posted on the OSSAA website at 7PM that evening.**
- Please ask your fans/parents to enter and exit the gym through the South gym/lobby exits. This will allow all fans the chance to watch their team perform.

DAY OF COMPETITION, NOVEMBER 6th, 2021

Teams

- Use the **south** parking lot (labeled in map) to park school vehicles, busses need to park at the back of the lot.
- **Use the Southeast doors** to enter and check in your team. (see map)
 - There will be only 3 floor passes for coaches allotted - no additional passes; no exceptions.
- Check In/Stretch/Warm Up
 - You will have a host to guide you through each area.
 - You will have 10 minutes to stretch in your area. You will have 10 minutes to warm up on a full set of mats.

Spectators

- Use southeast, and east parking lots to park
- Enter the activity center through south doors.
- **Ticket prices for Game Day regionals are \$7.00 for students and adults. The ticket is good for all-day of the Regional Competition.**

- Please use the south gym/lobby doors to exit the facility once your team has competed.
