## Volleyball Coaches Advisory Committee Meeting

November 6, 2020

The Volleyball Coaches Advisory Committee met via Zoom on November 5, 2020 at 4:30 p.m. Advisory Committee members present were Tom Williams, Piedmont High School; Jamie Fithian, Skiatook High School; Jenny Pearson, Cascia Hall Preparatory School; Heath Kufahl, Christian Heritage Academy; Erin Basinger, Corn Bible Academy; and Todd Goolsby - OSSAA.

The meeting was called to order, the role of the committee, and the protocol for advancing action items on the agenda were discussed.

- 1. A motion was made by Erin Basinger, seconded by Heath Kufahl. Vote: 5-0 Yes: Williams, Fithian, Pearson, Kufahl, Basinger. To pair in the proper numerical sequence (1-16, 2-15, 3-14, etc.) teams in the Class 3A Regionals, with the remaining teams to be seeded based on the following criteria:
  - a. OSSAA Rankings (up to 16)
  - b. Head to Head Competition
  - c. Common Opponents
  - d. Composite Record
- 2. A motion was made by Tom Williams, seconded by Jenny Pearson. Vote: 5-0 Yes: Williams, Fithian, Pearson, Kufahl, Basinger. To pair in the proper numerical sequence (1-16, 2-15, 3-14, etc.) teams in the Class 4A Regionals, with the remaining teams to be seeded based on the following criteria:
  - a. OSSAA Rankings (up to 16)
  - b. Head to Head Competition
  - c. Common Opponents
  - d. Composite Record
- 3. A motion was made by Heath Kufahl to move the Championship Dates for Classes 3A and 4A to Friday and Saturday of Week 15, seconded by Tom Williams. Vote 5-0 Yes: Williams, Fithian, Pearson, Kufahl, Basinger
- 4. A motion was made by Jenny Pearson to alternate the location of the Class 3A and 4A State Tournaments between the east and west sides of Oklahoma beginning with the 2022-2023 school year, seconded by Jaime Fithian. Vote 5-0 Yes: Williams, Fithian, Pearson, Kufahl, Basinger

## Discussion Items:

- 1. Eliminate the rankings system by all coaches at the Class 3A and 4A level and instead move to a committee of coaches to rank for each class.
- 2. Move the start date of volleyball season to match the start date of football.
- 3. Move the conclusion of volleyball season to the end of October.
- 4. Increase the State Volleyball Tournament in all classes to a three-day event to be held on a Thursday, Friday, Saturday and play in a larger event center. Play all 1st round games on Thursday, all semi-final games on Friday and all Championship games at one site on Saturday.
- 5. Allow for private/parochial schools to never play lower than the class their enrollment places them in.
