Action Items:

- 2. Motion made to put out question contract to vendors for a 3-year contract. Roger Gossen motion, John Foley seconded; motion carried 7-0

Discussion Items:

- 2. Give host the options to either receive a paper version of the question packet or an email version of the question packet.
- 3. Request to keep the brackets at the state tournament updated by round online.

  - Delete the "and response". Add the sentence "Any responses begun as the buzzer sounds can be completed."
- 9. Clarification of Item VI.C. page 8. Delete current sentence at C and number 1. The current 2 is modified and becomes "C".
  - Add the sentence "Scorekeeper will record the full names"
- 10. Clarification on page AC3. A and C should include "officials must be out of high school"
