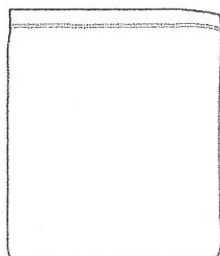

APPROVED BAGS (ONE BAG PER PERSON)

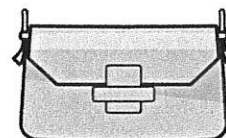

The approved clear plastic bag size is a maximum of 12 inches x 6 inches x 12 inches or a one-gallon clear plastic freezer bag. Even those bags are subject to search.

Non-transparent clutch wallets no larger than 4.5 inches by 6.5 inches are permitted.

Bags necessary for medical equipment will be searched at marked medical lanes at each gate.

No other bags or purses including diaper bags are permitted and the limit on bags is one per person.

It is still recommended that fans not bring bags of any kind to the arena. If it's possible to enter the arena empty-handed, it guarantees a quicker, smoother entrance.

Express lanes will remain in place at each gate for those who do not bring bags to the arena.

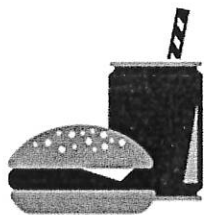
Only those items needed for medical or family needs plus empty, clear personal-sized containers suitable for drinking water are permitted. All carried items and entrants are subject to search. Any unlawful items are subject to confiscation, and the person in possession of such items is subject to arrest.

Prohibited items must be returned to the owner's vehicle or discarded. Items left at the gate will be discarded.

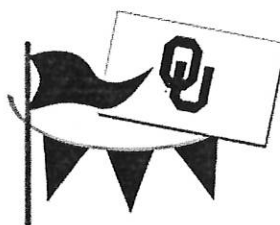

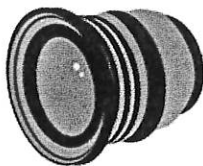

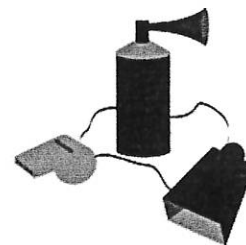

Prohibited items:

- Alcohol (in all forms)
- Baby seats
- Baby strollers
- Bags, backpacks, fanny packs & hard binocular cases
- Banners/signs
- Beach balls, footballs, balls or other sporting equipment
- Cameras with lenses longer than 6 inches
- Chair backs with frames, armrests and/or wider than 16 inches
- Coolers, containers or ice chests
- Explosives, firearms or weapons
- Folding chairs or stools
- Food or drink
- Laptops
- Laser pointers
- Noisemakers of any type (i.e. air horns, plastic horns, whistles, etc.)
- Personal heaters
- Pets (with the exception of registered service dogs)
- Selfie sticks, bi-pods, monopods, etc.
- Umbrellas (per Big 12 Conference)
- Video cameras

ENHANCED SCREENING

Metal detectors are located at each entrance. It is recommended that fans arrive sooner to allow extra time for entry. Arena doors open 90 minutes prior to each event.

Fans need only to empty only cell phones, keys and metal objects larger than keys from their pockets before screening. Fans are NOT required to remove belts, shoes or other small items such as coins, jewelry and watches.

If metal is detected, a person will be required to go through a secondary screening with a wand so other fans can continue to move through the metal detector.

Medical lanes are marked around the arena for fans who require alternate screening methods.

All permitted bags and those containing medical equipment will be searched at doors prior to entry.

All prohibited items must be returned to your vehicle or discarded prior to entry.

Restrooms

Men's restrooms are located in the upper concourse by sections: 205, 209 (ADA accessible), 219 and 223. Women's restrooms are located in the upper concourse by sections: 203, 211 (ADA accessible) 217 and 225.

Restrooms are available in the lower Legacy Court area as well.

Family restrooms are not available at the Lloyd Noble Center.

Private rooms for nursing mothers are available by request at either guest services kiosk.

Re-entry

There is no re-entry at the Lloyd Noble Center.

Severe Weather

In the event of severe weather, patrons should follow directions of event staff to designated shelter areas.

- Upper bowl ? Patrons may shelter in all restrooms and on the main concourse away from trophy cases.
- Lower bowl ? Patrons may shelter in the lower level ramp area, locker room hallways, restrooms or on the arena floor.

Smoking Policy

Effective July 1, 2012, the University of Oklahoma instituted a campus-wide, [Tobacco Free Policy](http://hr.ou.edu/policies/tobaccofree.asp?DB_OEM_ID=31000)

(http://hr.ou.edu/policies/tobaccofree.asp?DB_OEM_ID=31000). The use of all tobacco products (cigarettes - traditional and electronic, chewing tobacco, pipes, cigars, snuff, snus, hookah, bidis, clover cigarettes or water pipe smoking) is strictly prohibited anywhere on the OU grounds or campus, including Lloyd Noble Center.
