DATE: October 10, 2022

The 2022 Fast-Pitch Softball State Tournament brackets for Classes 4A, 5A and 6A are listed below. Please check dates and times carefully. Be sure to give yourself ample time to reach your assigned play-off field. It is your responsibility to have your team at the assigned site and ready to play at the assigned time.

All games will be played at Hall of Fame Stadium in Oklahoma City, 2801 NE 50th Street.

Game times and field assignments are on the State Tournament Brackets.

Additional State Tournament Information:

- There will be parking attendants on duty on Thursday to help with parking lot flow. Should the lot reach capacity; fans will be asked to park off-site. There may be a short walk to the stadium from over flow parking.
- The gates will open at 9:30 a.m. on Thursday
- For the state tournament, each team will be limited to twenty-two (22) suited squad members. Non-suited team members will be admitted free of charge.
- The team on the top line of the tournament bracket will occupy the third base bench area, and the team on the bottom line of the tournament bracket will occupy the first base bench area. A coin toss conducted by the umpire(s) assigned to your game will determine the home and visiting team.
- Team buses must drop athletes at the field house, and then follow the parking lot attendants instructions to bus parking. Athletes will be greeted by USA Staff and directed to their respective field. Coaches should enter with their team.
- **During the state tournament (all classes), no warm-up on the field will be allowed. All warm-up on all fields must be behind the outfield fences.**
- **Fences will be set at 200' and 220' in center.**
- Batting practice will be allowed in batting cages. Teams that are playing in next game will have priority in using batting cages.
- Teams may use space behind the outfield fences for warm-up throwing.
- At the Hall of Fame Stadium **teams must provide their own water in the dugouts.**
- No tobacco will be allowed in the bench or field areas.
- VIP lounge will not be open.
- **Teams should send their roster and school logo to jwhiteaker@usasoftball.com no later than 4 p.m. Tuesday, October 11.**

BEFORE EACH GAME, PLEASE BRING UPDATED TEAM ROSTER TO PUBLIC ADDRESS ANNOUNCER ON YOUR RESPECTIVE FIELD.

Trophies will be awarded to the championship and runner-up teams of each class. Also, twenty-two (22) team members of the championship and runner-up teams will receive individual medals.

The umpires will be assigned by the OSSAA.

The OSSAA will provide balls for the tournament.

The 2022 fast-pitch state softball tournament will consist of three sessions. Tournament play on each day will be considered a session. The link for tickets can be found on the homepage of OSSAA.com. Ticket links will open Monday, October 10 at 9 a.m.

Any group wishing to video live stream and/or televise an OSSAA playoff contest, regardless of length or where it is shown, must fill out the 2022-23 Video Live Streaming Agreement form found on the OSSAA website under the MEDIA tab and send it in for approval at least four (4) days prior to the event. Failure to fill out the form for approval will result in being charged the full amount plus \$100 the first round of the playoffs, the full amount plus \$200 for the second round of the playoffs, the full amount plus \$300 for the third round of the playoffs, etc. NFHS Network schools must fill the form out, but they will NOT be charged to video live stream. Please e-mail all requests to vsiven@ossaa.com. A link with all approved video live streams will be posted on the OSSAA website at least 24 hours before the contests take place.
