#### **ACTION ITEMS:**

The cap of 8-man playing schools increased to 96 (keeping the current criteria for 8-man participation to only allow schools that would fall in Class A to petition to play 8-man.) All 8-man schools to be classified as Class B. {Under the new guidelines, this could create three divisions within Class B.} Denied....0-16.

#### **DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

- 1. Adjustments to Rule 14 and possible playoff bracket adjustments were discussed.
- 2. Allowing schools to have 7 on 7 teams in the Spring Semester and conduct games/tournaments was discussed. This item will be forwarded to staff and the Athletic Director's group for further evaluation.
- 3. Using a formula for redistricting committees to use to create an objective determination coupled with geographic constraints was discussed.
- 4. The current game officials shortage and impact on regular season schedule was discussed and a template for district games to be rotated on Thursday/Saturday night will be posted on the OSSAA football page prior to the scheduling for the 2024 and 2025 seasons.
- 5. NFHS Rule Changes for 2023 were covered and explained.
- 6. A recommendation was made to inquire of the possibility of sending regional and area plaques to the site of the game for presentation after the contest concludes.
