- 1. No Action was taken.
- 2. Jade Allison made the motion to approve placing classes 5A and 6A in four 8-team districts, seconded by Shane Coffey. Passed 16-0
- 3. Jade Allison made the motion for classes 5A and 6A, any coach locked out of the last rankings for non-compliance with the ranking schedule will be suspended the first playoff game. There would be no points added/deducted in the rankings system for the final ranking. Seconded by Nick Gable. Passed 16 0
- 4. Mark Wilson made a motion to approve a double-elimination play-off structure for classes 5A and 6A, seconded by Christie Jennings. Passed 16 0.

Discussion Items:

- 1. NFHS rule prohibits dunking in pre-game warm-ups.
 All NFHS playing rules must be complied with during secondary level competition.
- 2. Play 4A girls and boys on separate nights for Districts.

 Determined this would cause patrons of a school to travel 2 nights rather than one, and pay admission twice as opposed to a double-header with one admission fee.
- 3. Shot clock.
 - The Committee asked the shot clock issue to be reconsidered by the OSSAA Board.
- 4. Discuss the process for a proposed change to the number of schools participating in Class A; and splitting Class B into two equal divisions.
 - This item will be taken out to Area Meetings in October 2023, any change would require a vote of the membership.
- 5. Discuss start times for play-off games.
 - First session games: 1:00 pm and 2:30 pm; second session games 6:00 pm and 7:30 pm
- 6. Play off committee.
 - Input is taken from all coaches.
