APPLICATION FOR ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Application must be postmarked no later than February 7 OR emailed no later than February 14.

REGULATIONS

- A. A team must list all wrestlers who compete in the regional tournament. There must be a minimum of seven (7) wrestlers compete in regionals to qualify for an academic award. The G.P.A. shall be based on grades from the preceding semester. (Non-traditional semester: An approximate 18-week grading period used to divide the school year in half.) The state champion shall be the team with the highest G.P.A.
- B. Teams must meet all qualifications required of the respective activity in order to qualify.
- C. Entries received after the entry deadline will not be considered. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form will also void the entry. Please report any corrections or changes on your academic application to the OSSAA office. The OSSAA will confirm finalists for the state championship award.
- D. The academic G.P.A. will be based on a 4 point system and computed to the nearest thousandth percentile: A=4.; B=3.000; C=2.000; D=1.000. If you have a weighted grading system it must be converted to a 4 point system in computing the team G.P.A.
- E. All classes that count toward graduation shall be used in determing each individual students G.P.A.
- F. Teams will be eligible to receive one award each year in each activity. The award will be for the highest level of achievement.

ACADEMIC AWARDS

- A. Academic Achievement Certificate. Teams must have a minimum 3.25 G.P.A. and rank in the upper 1/3 of their classification to qualify.
- B. Distinguished Academic Plaque. Teams must have a minimum 3.50 G.P.A. and rank in the upper 10% of their classification.
- C. State Academic Champion. The highest qualifying G.P.A. will be declared the State Academic Champion for their respective class.
